LITERACY-NUMERACY CATCH UP PREMIUM 2016-17

Background

The Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Premium provides schools with an additional £500 for each year 7 pupil who didn't achieve at least national Curriculum level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2. It is provided to all state-funded schools with a year 7 cohort, including special schools, alternative provision settings and pupil referral units.

Rationale

Our rationale for the use of Literacy-Numeracy Catch Up Premium, which the Governors have agreed, are that it must be used so that it:

- Enables the school to deliver additional support; individual tuition or intensive support in a small group
- Enables the year 7 students to reach their full potential

Allocation

For the academic year 2015-16 we received £1500 for three students

For the academic year 2016-17 we will receive £2000 for four students

Usage

Additional staffing provided to support identified students to work towards their literacy and numeracy targets.

Intended outcome

To support pupils to progress, to achieve their priority targets and to narrow the gap in attainment.
