



BREAKSPEARE SCHOOL SPORTS PREMIUM 2015-16

Background

In order to improve the provision of physical education and sport in primary schools the government is providing additional funding for primary school sport. This funding is given directly to schools to be spent on improving the quality of sport and PE for all children. All state-maintained schools, academies, middle schools, special schools and pupil referral units that have primary aged pupils in years 1-6 will receive the funding. This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can **only** be spent on provision for PE and sport in schools. All schools will be held accountable for how they have used the additional Sports Premium Funding to support pupils' progress and participation in PE and school sport.

Allocation

For the academic year Sept 2015 – August 2016 we expect to receive an amount of **£8100**.

Rationale

Our rationale for the use of Sports Premium funding, and which the Governors have agreed, are that it must be used so that:

- All students benefit regardless of their sporting / physical abilities
- Most students are given opportunities to compete in tournaments with other schools
- Staff have access to training opportunities and CPD
- Some activities may be subsidised so that the students do not miss out due to financial constraints
- Use of collaborative and partnership working

Usage

With the above rationale in mind and following the guidelines of how to spend this money, our initial plan for the use of the funding include;

1. Provide students with a wide range of sporting activities at school
 - Lunch time clubs; £1000 specialist coaches for dance and football
 - Purchase a table tennis table: £300
 - Purchase ASD specific outdoor equipment: 2000
 - Purchase VI-specific outdoor play equipment:1500
2. Provide students with access to a range of sporting activities in the community
 - Summer term 'out of school learning opportunities' in Rickmansworth sailing: £1150
 - Summer term 'out of school learning opportunities' in Bedmond Riding School: £1150
 - Additional staffing for participation in tournaments; £500
3. Further develop staff skills in Rebound
 - Rebound training for one member of staff: £500

Impact:

We will evaluate the impact of the Sports Premium funding as part of our annual self-evaluation. As a result of using Sports Premium effectively our provision has improved the quality and breadth of PE and sporting provision, developed lunch time clubs, included an increasing participation in PE and sport and leisure so that all pupils have developed healthy lifestyles and reached the performance levels they are capable of.
