On a weekly basis, some students attend West Herts College for one morning per week, travelling to and from the college via public transport.

Our students take part in a cooking lesson in which they are supported by West Herts students who are enrolled on the *Supporting Individuals with Learning Disabilities, level 3 CACHE* course. This provides our students with opportunities to interact with their mainstream peers as well as to improve their cooking skills.

As part of the morning's activities Breakspeare students take turns to prepare drinks and snacks to share at college and then use the college canteen at lunchtime. This provides valuable opportunities to put class based learning into a more practical environment, for example using communication skills to order their food and money skills to purchase their selection.

This weekly college experience not only enhances our students presence in the local community but also helps with the transition from school to college and integration with their mainstream peers.
