SPORTS PREMIUM 2021-22 IMPACT

Background

In order to improve the provision of physical education and sport in primary schools the government is providing additional funding for primary school sport. This funding is given directly to schools to be spent on improving the quality of sport and PE for all children. All schools will be held accountable for how they have used the additional Sports Premium Funding to support pupils' progress and participation in PE and school sport.

Allocation

For the academic year 2021 -22 received an amount of £9,613 sports premium.

Impact

1. To improve PE facilities at school	£5000	Development of new soft play room at Meadow Wood in garage conversion for Federation so money allocated from both schools premiums.	1. This soft play project was delayed so the allocation went towards the permanent canopy for Squirrels, the Breakspeare class at Meadow Wood. All activities, bikes, scooters and outdoor play activities can continue in all weathers.
2. To provide the students with a wide range of sport activities at school	£1000	Lunchtime clubs to include dance and wheelchair dance. External PE specialist such as multi skill / games coaches, tennis coaching	2. Tennis sessions have increased hand / eye coordination and turn taking and given opportunities to PMLD classes to have access to a new sport with adapted equipment.
3. To provide the students with a wide range of sport activities in the community	£2613	Summer term out of school sporting activities Horse riding Tournaments and games – Continue to develop PMLD sports active Sailing at Rickmansworth Aquadrome	3. The new horse riding provision gives pupils opportunities to ride horses and some pupils have ridden for the first time this year and to learn to look after animals. Sailing has given more pupils a chance to begin to learn to steer and control their own boat with supervision. Some SLD schools sports events have restarted and pupils took part in Boccia and Swimming Gala this year.
4. To further develop staff skills and ensure the quality of provision	£1000	Rebound therapy training for up to 4 members of staff to extend provision throughout school.
