SPORTS PREMIUM STRATEGY 2022-23

Background

In order to improve the provision of physical education and sport in primary schools the government is providing additional funding for primary school sport. This funding is given directly to schools to be spent on additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport. All state-maintained schools, academies, middle schools, special schools and pupil referral units which have primary aged pupils in years 1-6 will receive the funding. All schools will be held accountable for how they have used the additional Sports Premium Funding to support pupils' progress and participation in PE and school sport.

Allocation

For the academic year 2022 -23 we expect to receive an amount of £16520 and have a carry forward allocation of £14000, totalling £30,520

Rationale

Our rationale for the use of Sports Premium funding, which the Governors have agreed, are that it must be used to:

- Develop and add to the PE and sport activities we already offer
- Make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years
- All students benefit from the usage of sports premium regardless of their sporting / physical abilities
- Provide our students opportunities to access a wide range sports activities both in school and in community.
- Provide training opportunities for staff and CPD in developing their skills in PE
- Subsidise some sports activities so that the students do not miss out due to financial constraints
- To participate in sporting tournaments and games through the use of collaborative partnerships

Usage 2022-23. With the above rationale in mind and following the guidelines of how to spend this money, our plan for the use of the sport premium funding includes;

Aim		Money allocation	Actions
1	To improve PE facilities at school	£8000 (C/F from the previous year)	- This was committed to the installation of the new soft play room at Meadow Wood in garage conversion for Federation so money allocated from both schools premiums. This is both a physical and a sensory learning space so it will be timetabled so that Breakspeare classes can visit and use the room alongside the outdoor garden areas and have access to a free and purposeful learning environment within the Federation.
2	To provide the students with a wide range of sport activities at school	£2000	- External PE specialist such as multi skill / games coaches, tennis coaching
3	To provide the students with a wide range of sport activities in the community	£7000	- To provide pupils with increased opportunities to engage in off site visits for their physical development. This will include; - - Summer term out of school sporting activities

4	To further develop staff skills and ensure the quality of provision	£1500	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Rebound therapy training for up to 4 members of staff to extend provision throughout school.
5.	To develop the quality of physical equipment available for pupils, both indoors and outdoors	£6000 indoors (C/F from the previous year) £4020 outdoors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To develop the range of equipment / activities in the sensory circuit giving options to rotate equipment. - To extend opportunities for outdoor physical equipment including trampolines, adapted bikes, outdoor mobiles that will stimulate PMLD pupils to be more physically active outside.
6.	To facilitate the transport of groups of pupils to venues safely and ensure there are fewer barriers to organising trips.	£2000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - For the above trips to happen, it may be necessary to hire / loan an extra vehicle or pay for a driver for the day.
