- Update parents about school activities and timetables through termly class and whole school newsletters.
- Inform parents about the progress their child is making through written reports, EHCP meetings and parents evenings.
- Provide a home – school diary for written communication between teachers and parents which will be looked at and acknowledged on a daily basis.
- Share information about the school's practices.
- Listen to, and respond to, parents' views and opinions to develop our working partnership.

Parents / Carers will:

- Support the school in the vision and values it seeks to achieve.
- Support the school's ethos to celebrate and nurture our diverse, multi-cultural school community
- Take an interest in my child's learning, and play an active role in their progress.
- Attend parents meetings including EHCP's, parents' evenings and medical appointments.
- Use the home – school dairy on a daily basis to inform the school about events or details regarding the well-being, behaviour or any changes that may affect my child that day.
- Ensure regular attendance and inform the school if the child is absent.
- Sign up to the School Gateway to ensure a prompt response to information and requests.
- Be responsible for the personal care and well-being of my child for example by sending in swimming costume, and spare clothes when needed. Follow information and news shared on school's website.

Together we will achieve more if we:

- Communicate openly at all times.
- Support the child to achieve their best.
- Treat each other with dignity and respect.
- Share difficulties and work actively to resolve them.
- Celebrate the learning and success of the students as they grow and develop.
